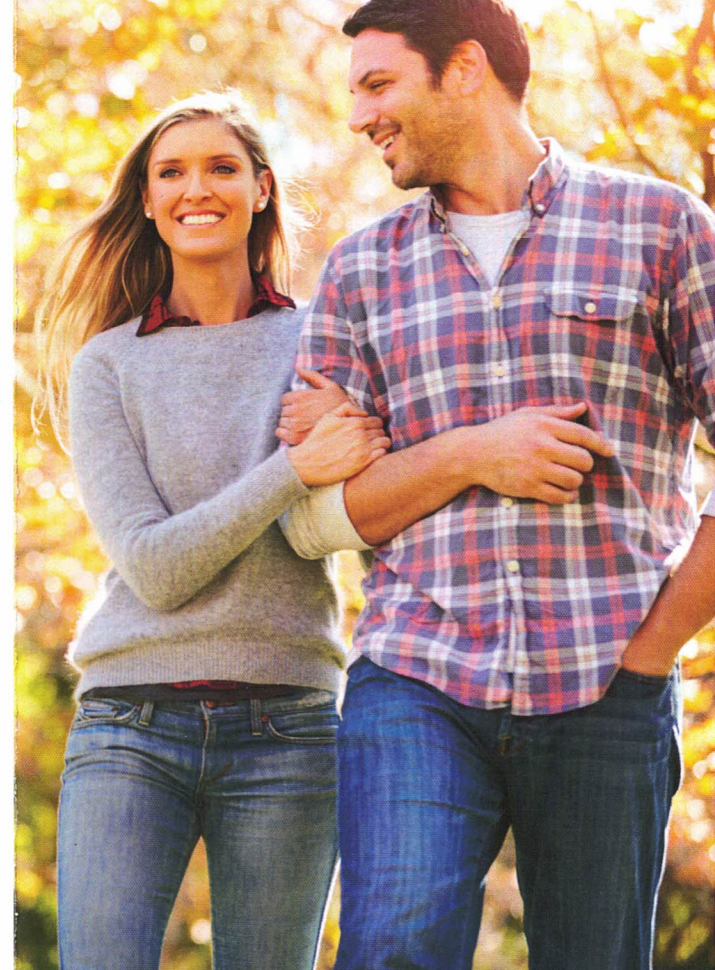

### SPOUSE'S RIGHT TO APPLY

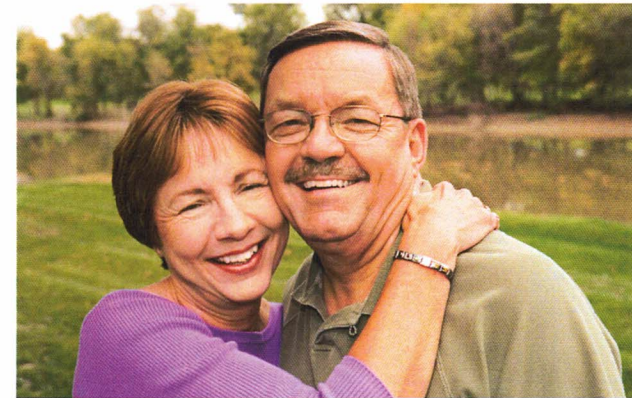
